Single Acre Farm is a small urban farm on, you guessed it, a single acre in Wesley Chapel, NC! The idea came about when April and Eric moved from their first home in hopes to have a bit more space to grow vegetables, fruit trees, berry bushes and flowers. At first, their gardens were planted with the idea of producing food for their family and inviting pollinators to the gardens with flowers. Over the years, the gardens expanded, and a high tunnel, chickens and bees were added as their knowledge grew. In 2017, a main garden bed was added which has the blackberries, and flowers. They began selling regenerative/sustainable/organically grown produce to customers through their on-farm table stand in 2018. After having multiple customers ask when the flowers would be available for sale, April started researching the need for local fresh bouquets. In 2019, Single Acre Farm focused on revamping the farm to offer fresh cut flower bouquets along with blackberries, honey, fresh, soy-free pastured (when available) free range eggs as well as occasional produce and herbs. Their goal is and always has been to leave the land in better condition than when they found it by being good stewards of the earth. They believe healthy soil and organic/sustainable/regenerative practices produce fantastically tasting blackberries, wonderfully fragrant fresh cut flowers, happy bees who make healthy honey, happy hens who lay healthy soy-free eggs.
